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Our department

Establishment History

The School of Health is affiliated to İnönü University, upon the request of the Ministry of Health and the proposal of the Higher Education Council, in line with the decision of the Higher Health Council dated 23.05.1995 and numbered 18/1, and the decision of the Council of Ministers numbered 96/8616, published in the Official Gazette dated November 2, 1996 and numbered 22805. was established. Our school started education in the 1997/1998 academic year and was connected to the newly established Adıyaman University in accordance with the paragraph (b) of the annex-68 article of the law numbered 5467 dated 01.03.2006.

Later, in the Official Gazette dated March 4, 2020 and numbered 31058, the School of Health was transformed into the Faculty of Health Sciences with the decision number 2222 of the Presidency.

Our Faculty of Health Sciences; It is an institution that trains nurses and midwives. 4-year undergraduate education is provided in the Department of Midwifery. My department serves 331 students with 2 Associate Professors, 5 Doctoral Lecturers and 2 Research Assistants.

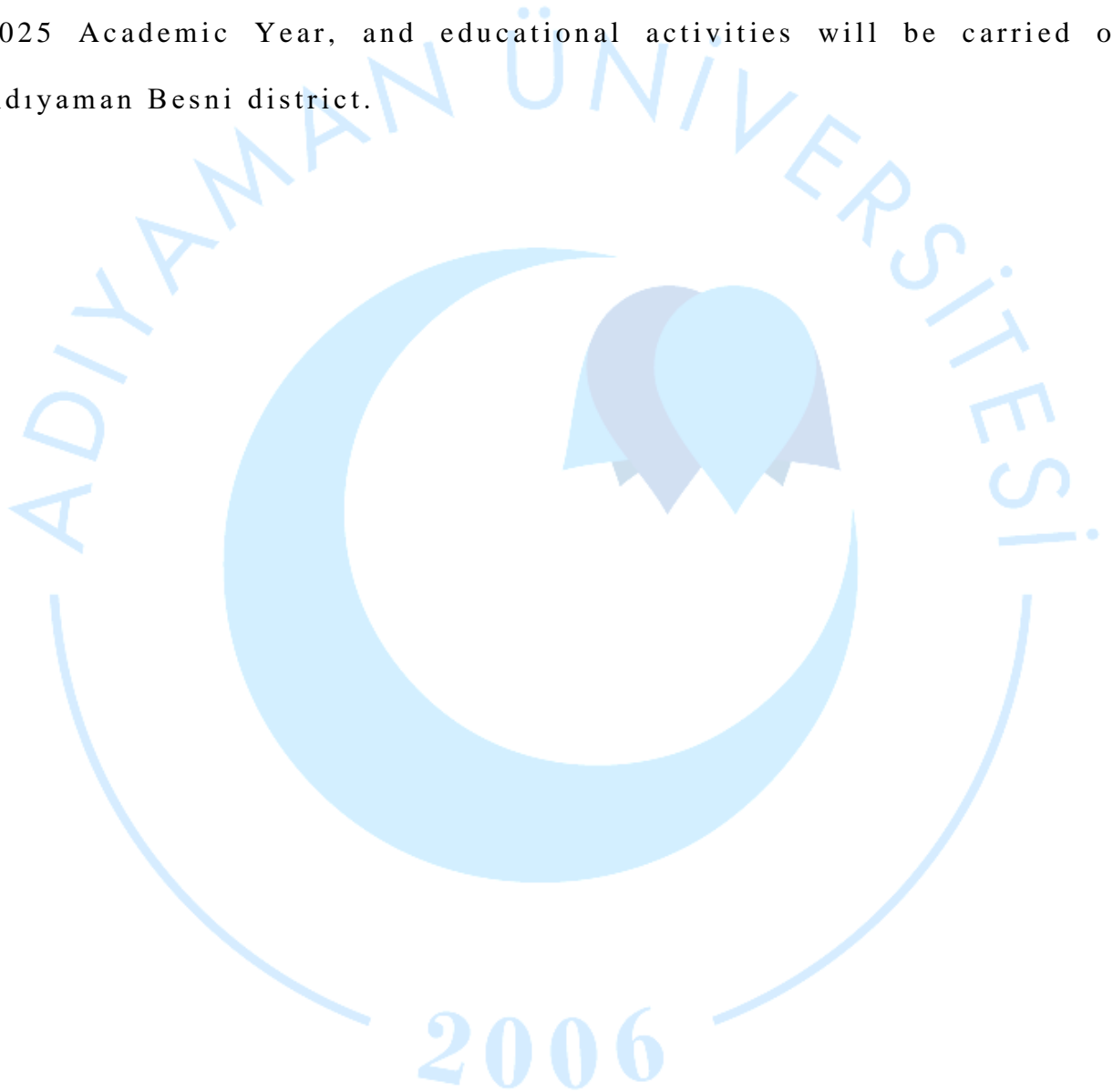

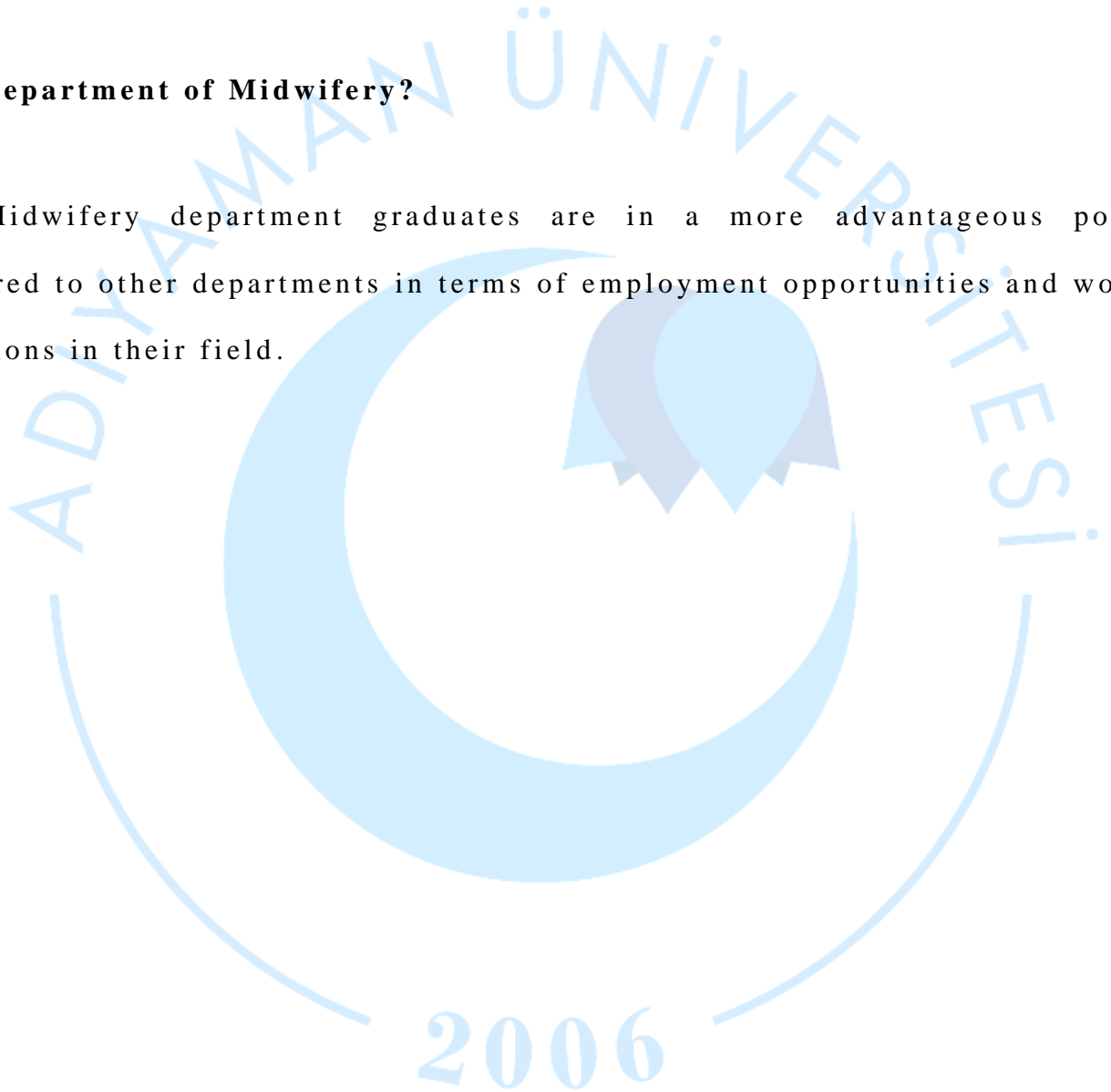
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The Importance of the Midwifery Department

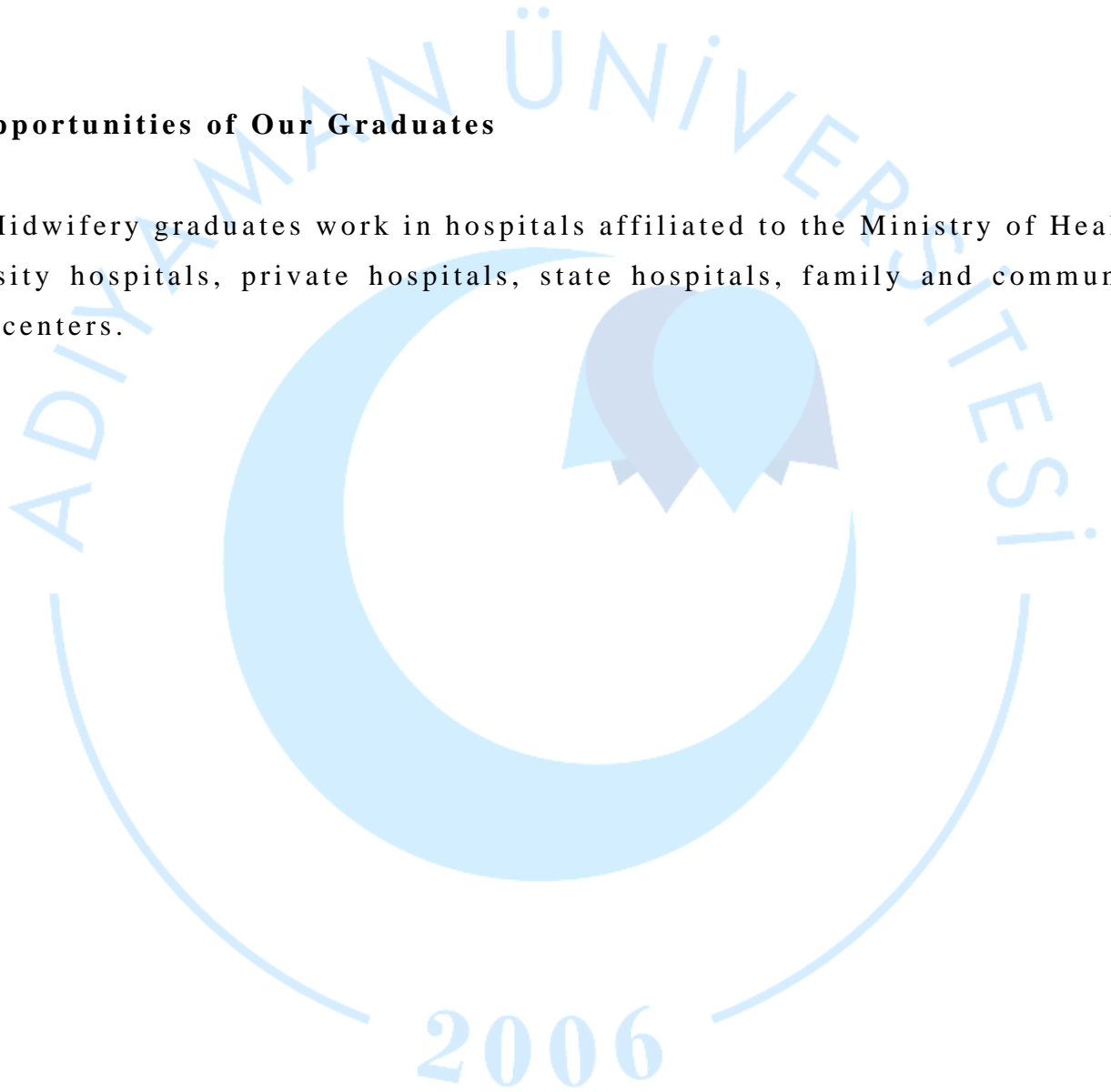
Why Department of Midwifery?

Our Highest and Lowest Placement Scores by Central Placement

According to the ÖSYS placement results announced by the Measurement, Selection and Placement Center Presidency in 2023, the highest student was placed with **354,818** points, while the lowest **327,600** points were placed. All 40 student quotas opened in total have been filled. 331 students continue their education in our department.
