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About Department

Sport is truly an intense effort to enhance one's ability to succeed and achieve personal peaks. It involves the goal of expanding success and excelling in competition. This requires selecting those with greater physical aptitude and developing them through continuous and intensive training.

The primary goal of the department of coaching education is to train contemporary and qualified coaches across fields and sports. The program aims to develop coaches (sports educators) who specialize in team and individual sports; prioritize ethical principles, prioritize athlete health and safety, work in a multidisciplinary manner for top-level performance, stay abreast of global scientific and technological advancements, and possess the skills to coach athletes of all ages.

To contribute to developments in sports, coaches must possess the knowledge, skills, and attitudes necessary for general knowledge, sports field knowledge, movement and training, sports health and psychosocial aspects, and coaching professional knowledge. The qualifications that courses or course groups in these areas provide coaches can be summarized as: fluent in and fluent in Turkish, computer literacy, foreign language proficiency, ability to communicate with others and utilize opportunities and resources, understanding the definition and historical development of sport, monitoring and evaluating sports-related research, analyzing human movements, understanding sports regulations, behaving responsibly towards the environment, being reliable, disciplined, and understanding society's expectations and needs from sport. In this area, university coaching departments have become an important resource for meeting the needs of the field. As can be seen, coaching encompasses sports fields that require specialization, various duties and responsibilities, and the knowledge and skills necessary to achieve these specializations. The Department of Coaching Education, established within the School of Physical Education and Sports at Adiyaman University, is poised to train the best coaches with its distinguished faculty. All target norms have been prepared in this direction.

This knowledge and skills equip students with the fundamental competencies to manage athlete development, develop training programs, manage teams, and support athletes in their performance.

Career Opportunities

Graduates of the Department of Coaching Education can work as coaches in professional sports clubs, amateur sports clubs, sports schools, universities, and other sports organizations. They also have opportunities to work in areas such as sports management, sports equipment design and production, sports media, sports law, and sports ethics. Graduates can pursue careers in the sports industry, managing athlete development, developing training programs, providing sports psychology consulting services, and managing the organization of sporting events.

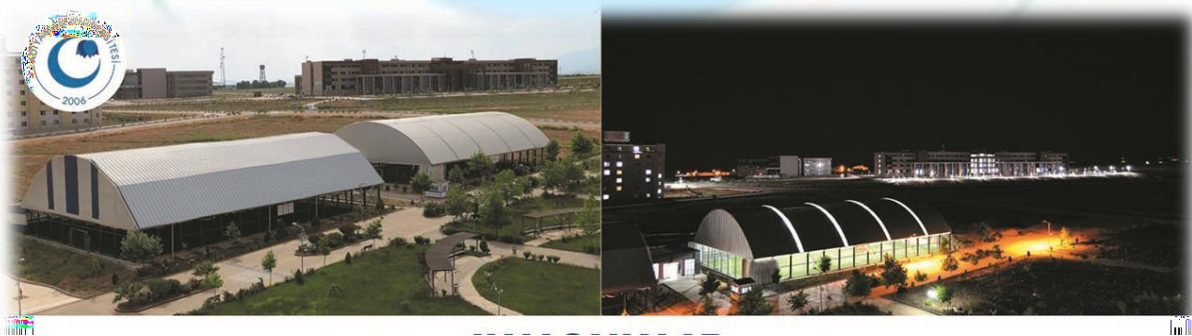

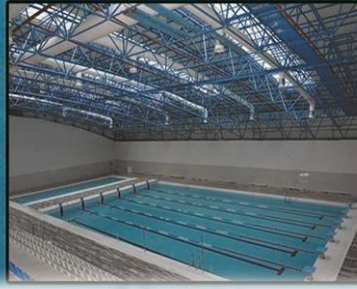
