Preparatory Education

The English preparatory education provided at the School of Foreign Languages at Adıyaman University is conducted in two formats: compulsory and optional.

√The program is designed based on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) and is offered at the A1, A2, B1, and B2 levels. Entry and exit levels are planned as follows:

- $-A1 \rightarrow B1+$
- $-A2 \rightarrow B1+$
- $-A1 \rightarrow B2$
- B1 → B2

√The courses focus on improving grammar, vocabulary, reading, and writing skills in an interactive and software-supported classroom environment.

Students who successfully complete the preparatory program reach at least the basic user or independent user level, and further reinforce these competencies in the compulsory common foreign language courses.

Examinations and Assessment

Throughout the preparatory program, students are required to take the following examinations:

- Proficiency Exam At the beginning of the academic year
- Placement Test
- 2 4 Midterm Exams 10%
- 2 4 Quizzes 5%
- ☑ End-of-Year Proficiency Exam 60%

At the end of each level, students' progress is evaluated in all four skills (reading, writing, listening, speaking).

☑ Compulsory Common Foreign Language Courses (YD 101 – YD 102)

- YD 101: Offered in the fall semester Exit level: A1
- YD 102: Offered in the spring semester Exit level: A2

These courses are delivered via the Distance Education System.

Attendance: Active participation in at least 70% of classes is mandatory.

Grading: Midterm (40%) + Final Exam (60%)
