



Program Profile

In the Architectural and Decorative Arts Program, training is provided to train intermediate manpower to work in businesses. Technical personnel are trained to have the necessary skills in production in industry, private and legal workshops, to acquire work habits that will increase the efficiency of production in the environment in which they work, to establish business, human and production relations, and to acquire design habits in line with innovations in the field of art and technology.

Graduates of the Architectural and Decorative Arts Program also work in interior and exterior architectural wall decoration areas, ceramic and sculpture art workshops, stained glass and plaster mold casting units. Students who successfully complete their education are given the title of "Architectural Decorative Arts Technician". They work as intermediate staff in public and private organizations.

Having knowledge about conceptual and practical management and its sub-branches in the field of Handicrafts and the skills to use this information (defining, evaluating, interpreting, analyzing and producing solutions), taking responsibility, being able to work independently, and having sufficient awareness about social rights, justice and cultural values.
