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## Our Highest and Lowest Placement Scores According to Central Placement

According to the ÖSYS placement results announced by the Presidency of Measurement, Selection and Placement Center in 2019, the highest student was placed in our “Banking and Insurance” program under the Department of Finance, Banking and Insurance with a score of **314.967010**, while the lowest placed student was entitled to register with a score of **196.031270**. While the occupancy rate of 40 student quotas opened in the year it started its education-training life was 100% completed, today 33 students continue their education in our program with an occupancy rate of over 80%.

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## **Our Finance, Banking and Insurance Department Activities**

Finance, Banking and Insurance Department, “Banking and Insurance” program students are trained for 2 years (4 semesters) with theoretical and practical courses related to their professional life within the framework of both academic and ethical principles and the equipment needed by the sector. In this process, they are subject to 20 working days of compulsory internship training in order to transform the theoretical knowledge they learn into practical knowledge. In addition, they are provided with a close understanding of the sector through technical trips to the extent required by the profession and the possibilities allow.

Of course, in addition to all these, social activities such as folk dances, instrument courses such as bağlama or guitar, and football tournaments for male students are held to support and contribute to the social and cultural development of students.
