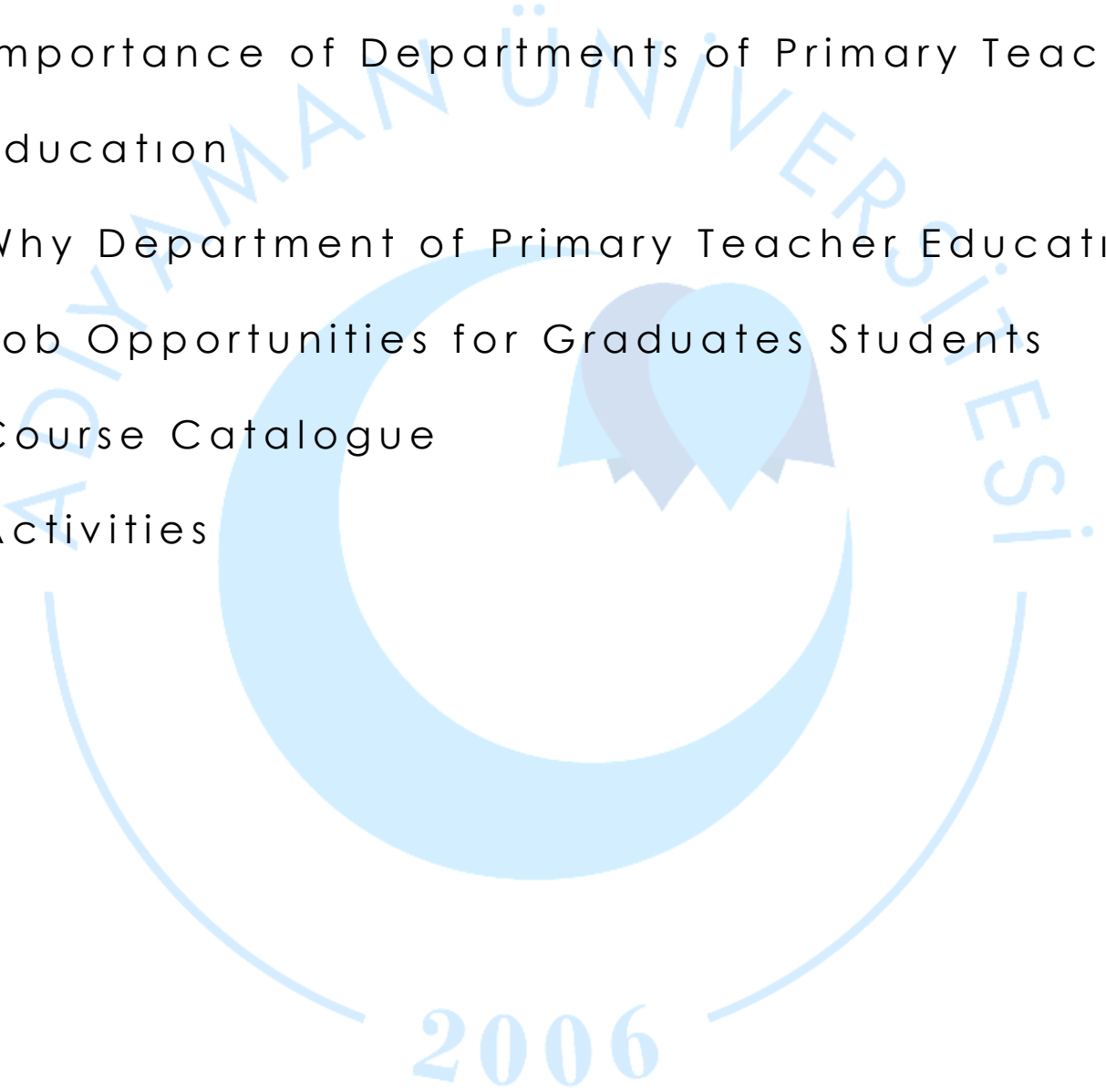

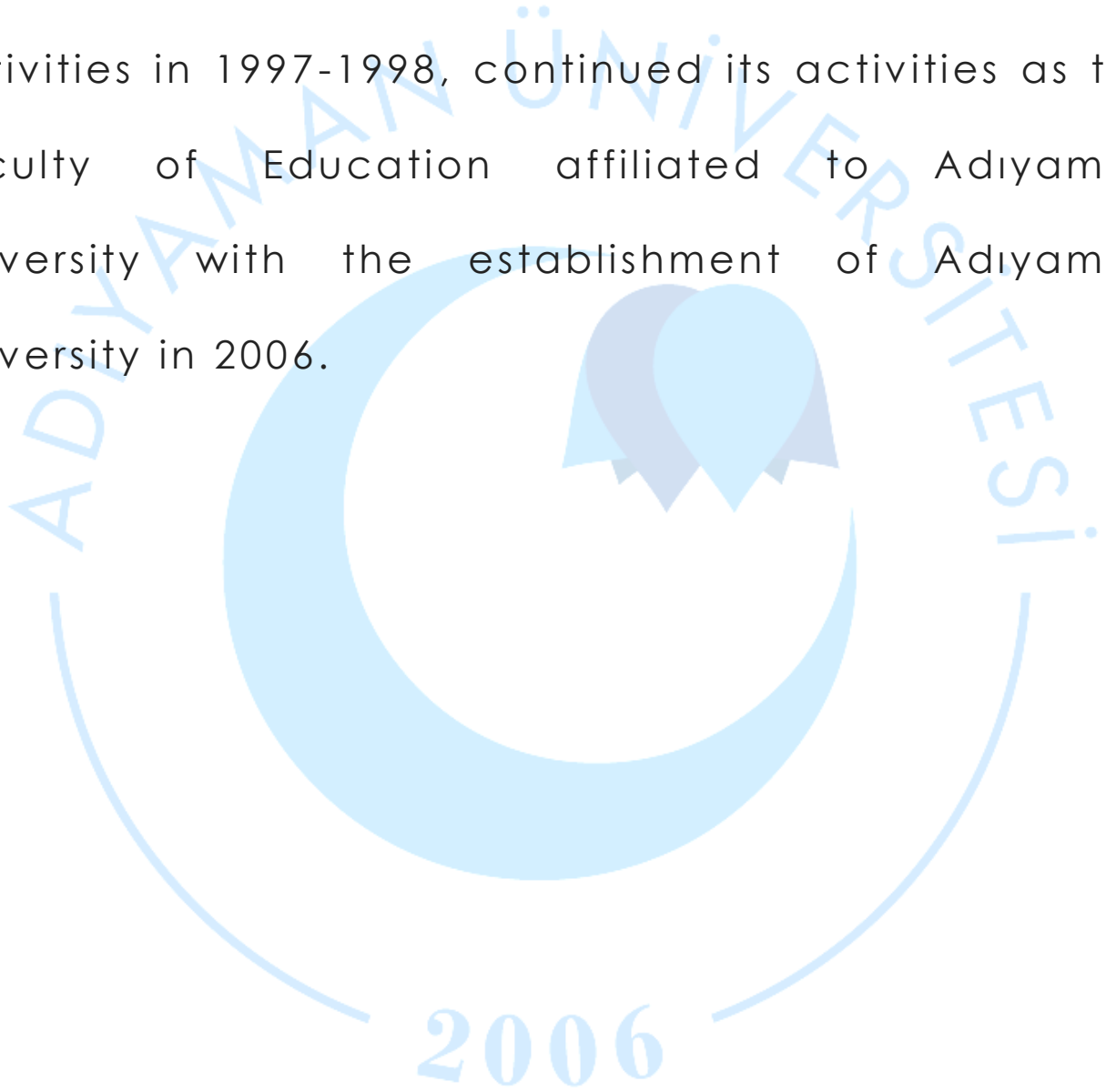
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Department of Primary Teacher Education

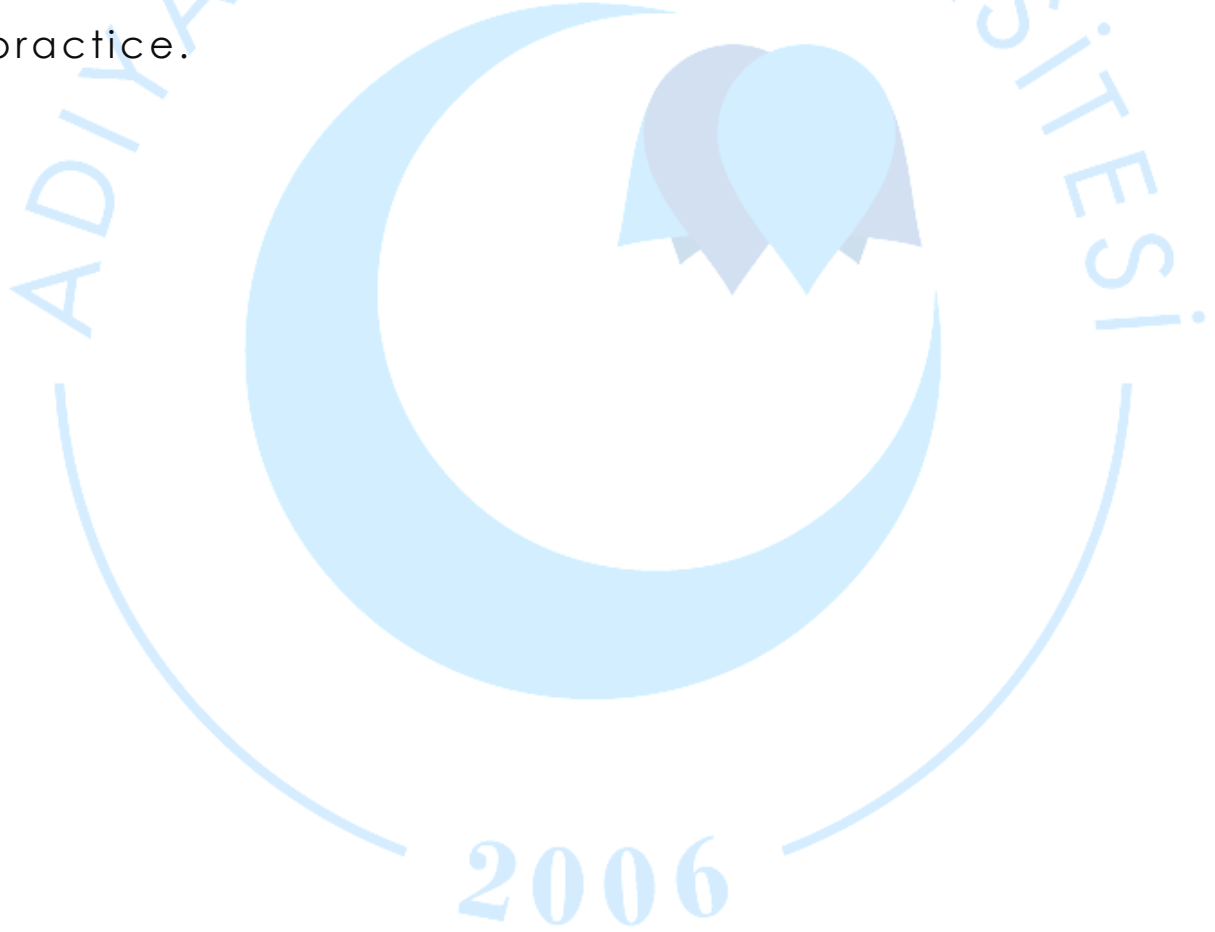
Mission & Vision

Importance of Departments of Primary Teacher Education

The scientific, technological, economic and cultural future of countries depends on the academic standards that teachers maintain in educational institutions. Teacher education programs have an important role in the formation of these standards. Social, cultural, pedagogical and technically equipped teacher training is directly proportional to the quality of the applied curriculum. In developed countries, there is an expectation that teacher education programs should be prepared with a continuous development and that they will be able to prepare teachers who can challenge the change in the world for the profession. In this context, it is also important to train teachers for primary schools, which constitute the first academic life step of individuals in the society.

Why Department of Primary Teacher Education?

The importance of the role of teachers in learning-teaching environments is increasing in the world. While the teacher was the only source and transmitter of knowledge in the traditional sense, today it has come to a position that teaches students the ways of learning. In order to develop these new roles and competencies expected from teachers, the necessity of new developments in teacher education programs and teacher training systems emerges. For this reason, it is important to train teachers who have the necessary equipment and skills at the primary school level, which is the beginning of the education life of the students.

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Job Opportunities for Our Graduate Students

Students who successfully complete the Primary Teacher Education Undergraduate Program can continue their graduate and doctorate programs at our university or other universities if they wish. In the most general sense, our graduates are employed as teachers in primary schools, private schools and private teaching institutions affiliated to the Ministry of National Education, and they can also work as research assistants, lecturers and lecturers in related departments of universities.

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Importance of Department of Pre-school Education

During pre-school education, children learn to share, cooperate, socialize, and work together as they become ready for primary education. The aim of pre-school education is to arouse interest in children's learning and to make the children's existing abilities visible. Preschool education, which is the first step of education, is the first button of the shirt and it must be buttoned correctly. Covering the years from the day the child was born to the day s/he started primary education and playing an important role in the later lives of children; pre-school education is a process in which physical, psychomotor, social-emotional, mental and language developments are completed to a large extent, the personality is shaped and the child is constantly changing and developing. For this reason, it is important for the child to continue his/her development in a healthy environment at a young age.

Why Department of Pre-school Education?

Early childhood is the beginning point of human development. Pre-school education supports the developmental areas of the child, enabling him/her to be more productive in adulthood, and to reveal his/her existing potential more easily, and eventually, to discover himself/herself.

Job Opportunities for Our Graduate Students

Graduates of pre-school education can work as educators and managers in public and private educational institutions such as kindergartens, day care centers, pre-schools and children's clubs. In addition, they can open and run a private kindergarten. They can work as educators and administrators in non-governmental organizations serving children and families, as well as in written and visual media, and software institutions related to pre-school education with their expertise. In addition, they can continue postgraduate studies in their own fields and take part as academic staff of universities.
