Why English Language and Literature Department?

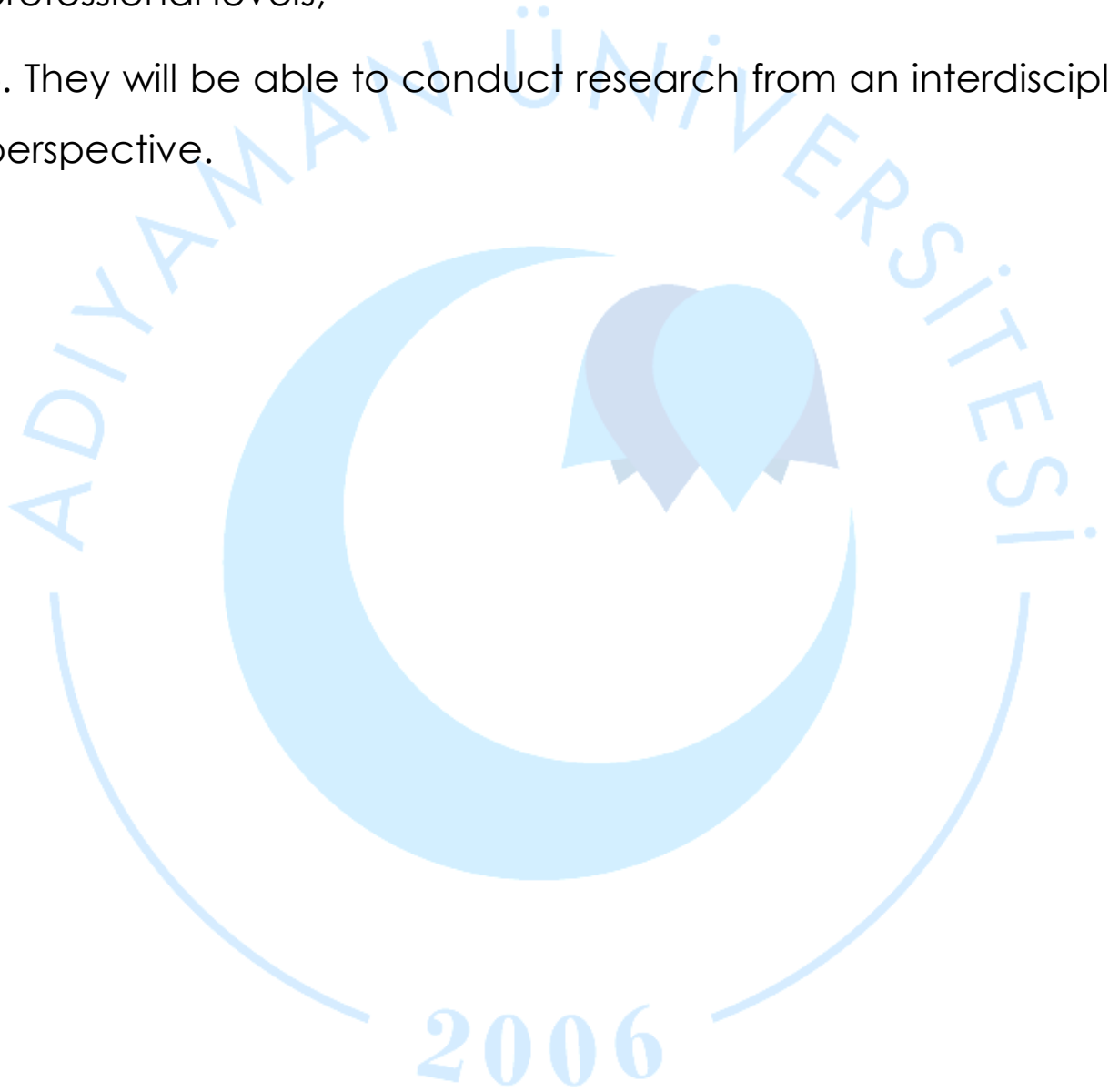
