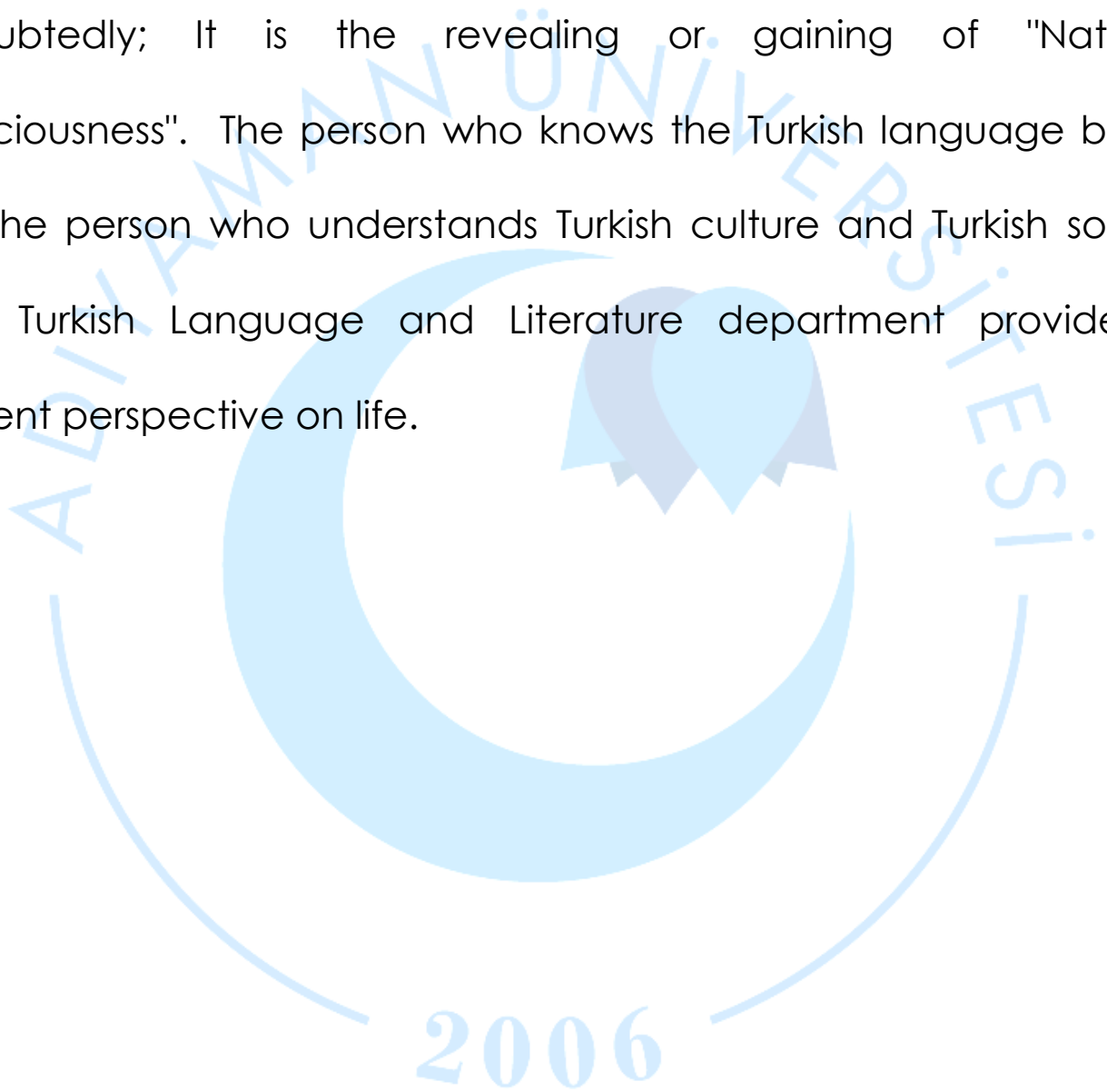

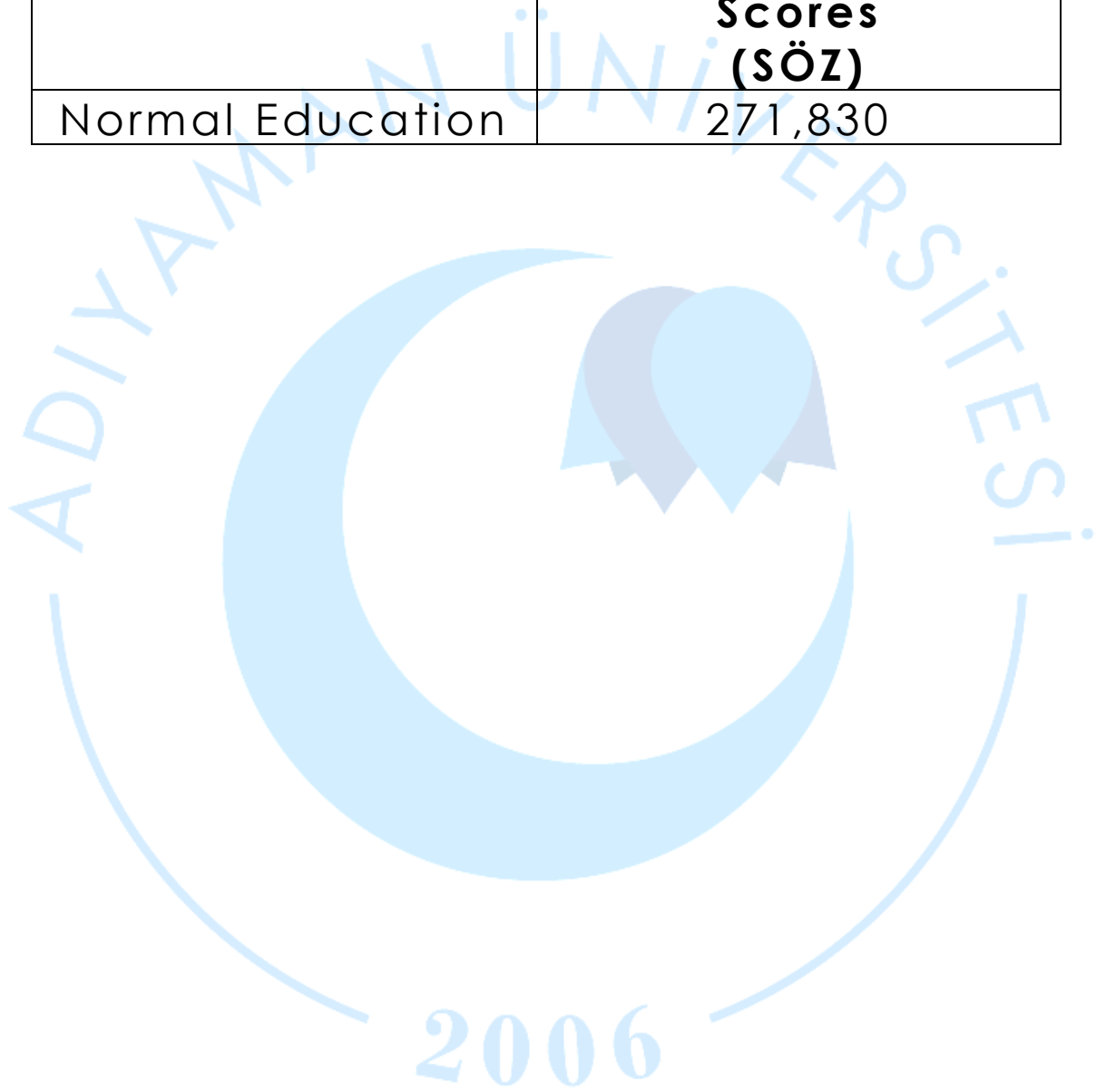
- Can teach in all public and private schools affiliated to the Ministry of National Education;

Our Activities

Our department organizes a wide range of academic, cultural, artistic, and social activities every academic year. Our faculty members are frequently invited both to national and local media platforms as well as to schools affiliated with the Ministry of National Education, where they contribute through panels, conferences, and various academic platforms, sharing their knowledge and expertise.

During the 2024–2025 academic year, our faculty members also organized significant events. Within this scope:

The “Mehmet Akif Ersoy Panel” explored the intellectual world and literary works of our National Poet from different perspectives. The National Will Against the July 15 Coup Attempt Conference offered an academic

evaluation of one of the most critical turning points in our recent history.

Our students also actively participated in these activities, reflecting the unifying power of literature and art in society. In the event titled “Reflections of Light in Verses: A Recital of Naat Poems”, they expressed their emotions and ideas through poetry. In addition, esteemed author Serkan Türk met with our students for a conversation, followed by a book signing event, where he shared his insights into the subtleties of literature with young readers.
