

ADIYAMAN UNIVERSITY ACCEPTANCE OF FOREIGN STUDENTS

APPLICATION GUIDE

2025-2026



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1. GENERAL INFORMATION

- a) Quotas for the admission of international students are determined by the relevant academic unit before each academic year, in accordance with the programs listed in the previous year's Higher Education Programs and Quotas Guide (YKS Guide), and submitted to the Senate for approval by the deadline set by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK). In programs such as Teacher Education, Law, Medicine, Dentistry, and Pharmacy, which are included in the quotas for international student admission as determined by the Council of Higher Education, the quota for international students must not exceed 10% of the total quota allocated to these fields.
- b) According to Article 45/f of the Higher Education Law No. 2547, as amended by Law No. 6287, and the "Principles Regarding Admission of International Students" determined by the Council of Higher Education, candidates who meet the eligibility criteria can apply for the international student quotas. These include candidates who were born Turkish citizens but later renounced Turkish citizenship with the permission of the Ministry of Interior, those who can certify that they hold a Blue Card, and dual nationals (one of whom is a Turkish citizen) who have completed their entire high school education abroad (excluding TRNC high schools). For detailed information about accepting international or foreign students, see "Adiyaman University Please review the Directive for Admission of International Students.
- c) For detailed information regarding the admission of international or foreign students, please refer to the "Adıyaman University Directive on Admission of International Students."
- d) For communication (e-mail, WhatsApp, etc.) with applicants to Adıyaman University, Turkish and English will be used as the communication languages.
- e) In cases not covered in this guide, the decisions of Adıyaman University will be applied.

2. APPLICATION PROCEDURES

a) Admission of International Students

1. According to Article 14/f of Law No. 6287, published in the Official Gazette No. 28261 on 11.04.2012, international student admission is conducted in accordance with the







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"Principles Regarding Admission of International Students" of the Council of Higher Education, the "Adıyaman University Directive on Admission and Registration of International or Foreign Students," and the relevant decisions of the Council of Higher Education.

b) Who Can Apply?

For the 2025 International Student Admission Quotas:

Candidates who are in their final year of high school or have graduated may apply, provided that:

- 1. They are foreign nationals. (Those who received education in Turkish secondary/high schools must have enrolled before the 2022–2023 academic year. This does not apply to embassy schools, international private schools in the MOBIS system, or foreign nationals brought to Türkiye under projects carried out by the Ministry of National Education.)
- 2. Those who were born Turkish citizens and later renounced Turkish citizenship with the permission of the Ministry of Interior, and those who can certify that they hold a Blue Card (provided they enrolled in Turkish high schools before the 2022–2023 academic year). (According to Article 7 of the Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901, "(1) A child born to a Turkish mother or father within a marriage, either in Türkiye or abroad, is a Turkish citizen." Applicants are encouraged to review the Turkish Citizenship Law before applying.)
- 3. Those who acquired Turkish citizenship after being foreign nationals / dual nationals in this situation (provided they enrolled in Turkish high schools before the 2022–2023 academic year).
- 4. Turkish citizens who completed their entire secondary education (high school) in a foreign country other than TRNC (including Turkish schools abroad officially recognized by the Ministry of National Education).
- 5. TRNC nationals who reside in TRNC and have completed their secondary education (high school) in TRNC and possess GCE AL exam results, and those who enrolled in colleges or high schools in other countries between 2005 and 2010 and hold or will hold GCE AL exam results; or TRNC nationals who completed their entire secondary education (high school) in a foreign country and have a valid TR-YÖS score.





c) Who Cannot Apply?

- 1. Turkish citizens who completed their entire secondary education (high school) in Türkiye or TRNC.
- 2. TRNC nationals (except those who completed their entire high school education in TRNC and have GCE AL results, those who studied in other countries between 2005– 2010 and have/will have GCE AL results, or those who completed their entire secondary education in a foreign country and have a valid TR-YÖS score).
- 3. Dual nationals whose first citizenship was Turkish by birth, as defined in clause a/2 (except those meeting the conditions in clause a/4).
- 4. Dual nationals with one nationality being TRNC (except those with GCE AL results or those who completed their high school education in a foreign country and hold a valid TR-YÖS score).
- 5. Turkish citizens or dual nationals whose first citizenship was Turkish by birth, who received their high school education at foreign high schools or embassy schools located in Türkiye.
- 6. TRNC nationals, Turkish citizens who renounced citizenship, Blue Card holders, and foreign nationals who will enroll in Turkish high schools from the 2022–2023 academic year onward (excluding those brought to Türkiye through projects coordinated by the Ministry of National Education, as well as those attending embassy schools or international private institutions in the MOBIS system), will not be accepted.

ATTENTION!

▲ T.R. nationality or first nationality by birth is Turkish Republic. Candidates with dual citizenship who have completed their entire secondary education (high school) and who have completed their education in TRNC. Except for those who completed it in a foreign country; Applications of candidates who have received a diploma from a high school abroad through distance education without being abroad will not be accepted.

A Candidates who have a diploma obtained through formal education from a high school abroad will be asked to prove their entry and exit to the country where the diploma was received with their passport or police records, and if a discrepancy is detected in the duration of high school education and the entry and exit dates of the country, the applications of such candidates will not be accepted.







1. ACCEPTED EXAMS/DIPLOMAS FOR APPLICATION

TR-YÖS Exam Result

a) At the meeting of the General Assembly of Higher Education held on 22.11.2022, it was decided that starting from 2023, the Turkish Exam for International Students (TR-YÖS) would be administered by ÖSYM. This exam is intended for candidates who wish to study at higher education institutions in Türkiye under international student status, and TR-YÖS results will be used in the admission process.

b) According to the principles set by the Council of Higher Education, during the evaluation of applications for international student admission, there will be **no expiration limit** for high school graduation-type exams (e.g., Abitur, International Baccalaureate, GCE, Tawjihi, etc.). However, **university entrance exams** (e.g., SAT, TR-YÖS, etc.) will have a **validity period of two years**.

Note: In case of delays due to visa procedures and/or based on instructions to be issued by the Council of Higher Education, candidates who gain the right for final registration may be granted an extension until 30.11.2025, with the approval of the International Student Coordination Office, provided that the quota of the related program is still not full (including backup admissions).

If no applications are received or the quotas determined by the Council of Higher Education are not filled in a program accepting international students:

- a) No quota transfer is allowed to Dentistry, Pharmacy, Law, Teaching, or Medicine programs.
- b) For other programs, quota transfer within the same faculty/school/vocational school is allowed upon University Senate approval.







Note: If the quotas are not filled, a new announcement will be made, and the application calendar will be updated accordingly.

4. TUITION FEES / CONTRIBUTION PAYMENTS

The tuition fees and student contribution fees for international (associate and undergraduate) students who gain the right to study at our university will be determined and announced by the University Administrative Board in accordance with the annual Presidential Decree regarding "Student Contributions to Current Service Costs and Tuition Fees at Higher Education Institutions."

Important: If a student who has completed registration later requests withdrawal, the paid tuition will not be refunded.

Regardless of status, all students registered under international student status are obliged to pay the annual tuition fee.

Note: The International Student Coordination Office may revise the application calendar. Any changes will be announced on the official website of the Coordination Office.

The Turkish Proficiency Exam will be announced by the TÖMER Unit on its official website.

Adıyaman University does not have an agreement with any person, institution or organization (educational institution, consultancy company, etc.).

During the registration process, no candidate is required to pay any fee other than the tuition fee to be made to the official account of our University, and do not pay any fee to anyone!


Please DO NOT rely on people who request a fee from you using the name of our University for application, placement and registration procedures.



Step: Create a new User

You can access the page below by clicking on the "Online Application" link, which is active between the dates specified in the calendar. https://obs.adiyaman.edu.tr/oibs/foa app/login.aspx from application to the process before starting before "Create a New User" by clicking the button user registration you to create is required.



3. Step: Login to the System

After creating a user registration, enter the "E-Mail Address" and "Password" information you have determined on the website https://obs.adiyaman.edu.tr/oibs/foa_app/login.aspx and click on the "Login" button and click on the "Adiyaman University Online" button. You will reach the "Application System" screen.



Enter your e-mail address, password and the sum of the numbers. If you forgot your password, follow the steps below. follow. Otherwise, go to Step 3.









Step: Switching to the Application Screen








Click "Add New Application" to select the first of your applications. If there is no section you want to choose on the first screen, click on the "Save and Proceed" link to move on to the next section.



STEP: Entering Credentials



You will enter your passport number in this field. (Temporary Protection Identity Certificate holders must enter their National Identity Number starting with 99 in this field.)

You must fill in the Name and Surname fields as written in your passport or "Temporary Protection Identity Document" and in capital letters. You must fill in the Mother's Name and Father's Name fields in the same way as written in your passport or "Temporary Protection Identity Document" and in capital letters.

After filling in your ID Information and adding your photo, select "Save and Proceed".











STEP: Entering Contact Information

If you have not received an expulsion penalty from a university before, select the "I have not received an expulsion penalty" section and then select "Save and Proceed".











Step: Entering TR-YÖS exam information

In this step, enter your High School graduation information correctly. Do not use abbreviations when writing the name of your high school and make sure that your grading system and GPA are written correctly. Select "Save and Proceed" to proceed to the next stage.











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10. STEP: Uploading Mandatory Documents



Select the "Mandatory" Documents in the "Documents" section one by one, add the document date and description where necessary, and then complete the document by "UPLOAD and SAVE" from the "Upload Document" section. These steps must be repeated for each document. According to the directive, the applications of candidates who make "misleading information/document entries" will be deemed invalid. Therefore, it is your responsibility to upload your documents correctly. Then select "Save and Proceed".


The candidate who has permission to renounce Turkish citizenship or has a "Blue Card" must submit a Certificate of Renunciation of Turkish Citizenship or a Certificate of Population Registration Sample (documents obtained through the E-Government service are valid) (The date of renunciation of citizenship must be stated in the document) or a Blue Card . (The files must be combined into 1 file. Because only 1 file can be uploaded. File of extension PDF to be And of size -most more 5 MB to be required)








11. STEP: Entering TR-YÖS Score



In the "Exams" section, you should provide information about the exams you have taken so far (TR-YÖS, international exams, university entrance exams, central high school graduation exam, language exams, etc.) and the scores you received in these exams. Please note that while applications are being evaluated, candidates will be ranked according to the exams they write here. Please Upload your document from the "select file" section. Then select "Save and Proceed".



12. STEP: Add Program Preferences and Complete the Application



In this step After selecting the programs that match your preferences in "Program" Preferences", click "I accept and undertake that the information I have entered in this form is correct." Check the box and click "Save" Complete your application by pressing the button.








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When you complete your application, you confirm that all the information you have provided is correct and that you will comply with the rules determined by ADYU during the candidate selection process.



5. EVALUATION AND PLACEMENT PHASE

The placement process is done according to score superiority and preference order. In case of equality in these criteria, priority is given to the younger candidate. Among candidates who choose the same program with the same score, priority is given to those who are younger.

- Candidates can only be placed in one program.
- With the TR-YÖS result, three preference and additional placement periods were created in the application type.
- In the application type with TR-YÖS result; Candidates who cannot be placed in any program during the 1st placement process, or who are placed in any program but do not complete the pre-registration process, will be placed in an additional placement process in the same category between the specified dates.
- Meeting the application requirements does not grant the right to be placed in the program.
- If necessary, Adıyaman University may make additional placements other than the placements in the calendar specified in this guide. Details regarding additional placement are announced on the International Student Coordination website.

6. ANNOUNCEMENT OF PLACEMENT RESULTS

- Placement results From the website https://iso.adiyaman.edu.tr/ advert will be done.
- Candidates will be able to view the placement result by logging in through the system on the announced date.
- No further notification will be made to the candidates.

7. PRE-REGISTRATION AND ACCEPTANCE LETTER

- i.A candidate who is placed in any department/program will pre-register through the system for the department/program he/she has been placed in.
- ii.On the dates when pre-registration begins, registrations cannot be made through the application system without payment.
- iii. The candidate who completes the pre-registration process will be able to receive the acceptance letter through the system.
- iv. An acceptance letter will not be sent to the candidate who does not pre-register within the prescribed period or who completes it incompletely, and the candidate is deemed to have given up his/her right to final registration to the department in which he/she has been placed.
- v.Candidates who have not completed their application, whose application has been deemed invalid/cancelled or deleted, or who have not completed the registration process for the program they have been placed in will not be subject to final registration.

8. CERTAIN REGISTRATION

must apply personally to the Registrar's Office for registration between the dates specified in the academic calendar for foreign students every year .

- Registration is not possible by mail or through anyone other than the candidate.
- Those who submit falsified, fake, incomplete or incorrect documents during the application, placement and registration process will not be registered, and even if their final registration has been made, the transaction will be canceled and legal action will be taken.
- issued by the Foreign Representatives of the Republic of Turkey or notaries of the Republic of Turkey cannot register.
- Those who do not register within the period specified in the calendar are deemed to have lost their rights.

a) DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR FINAL REGISTRATION

- The original of the high school diploma or temporary graduation certificate and its Turkish translation approved by a notary or Turkish Foreign Representatives,
- The original copy of the high school diploma and the Equivalence Certificate obtained from the Provincial Directorates of National Education of the Ministry of National Education of the Republic of Turkey or Turkish Foreign Representatives,
- An official transcript approved by the high school directorate, showing the courses taken by the candidate in high school, their grades and GPA, and a copy of its Turkish translation approved by a notary or Turkish Foreign Representatives,
- Those who are TRNC citizens, reside in TRNC and have completed their secondary education in TRNC and have GCE AL exam results, and those who have or will have GCE AL exam results by registering and studying at colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005-2010, GCE AL result certificate. and a copy of its Turkish translation certified by a notary or Turkish Foreign Representatives,
- Printout of the result document of the exams shown in the table in Annex-1 (if there is no verification code, it will not be considered valid),
- A copy of the visa-bearing passport's pages showing identity information and validity period and its Turkish translation, certified by a notary or Turkish Foreign Representatives,
- If available, a copy of the internationally valid Foreign Language Certificate and Turkish Proficiency Certificate certified by a notary or Turkish Foreign Representatives,
- Two 4.5x6.0 cm size photographs (must be taken within the last six months, from the front, in a way that can easily identify the candidate),
- Bank receipt showing that the tuition fee has been deposited to the relevant bank,
- Those with dual citizenship who were foreign nationals by birth and later became Turkish citizens are required to submit a Certificate of Population Registration Copy.

9. Turkish proficiency level (ADYÜ-TÖMER)

The Turkish level of all candidates who have registered for associate and undergraduate programs is determined according to the results of the Turkish proficiency exam held within the framework of the principles determined by the University TÖMER Directorate before the start of the academic year. The candidate who does not have B2 level Turkish proficiency is registered at TÖMER. Students who successfully complete a one-year Turkish education at TÖMER and pass the Turkish proficiency exam begin their education in the program they are accepted to. Students who fail the Turkish Proficiency Exam after one year of education are given an additional year. The course fee of the student registered to TÖMER is not included in the tuition fee.

A Turkish Proficiency Certificate is not required for international or foreign students who have graduated from a Turkish high school abroad or a Turkish high school in Turkey.

Only one year of the time spent in Turkish language education is not counted as part of the education period of the department in which the student will enroll. Students who fail to achieve Turkish proficiency within two years lose all their education rights and their registrations are deleted.

The student who takes Turkish and foreign language preparatory education simultaneously pays both the tuition fee of the program he is registered in and the Adyü-Tömer tuition fee.
